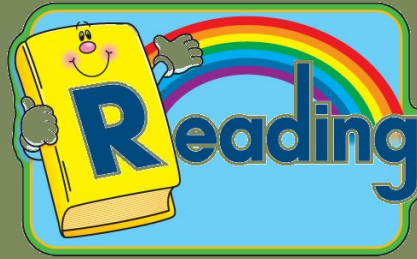

If you have any changes such as address, work, phone number or other, please let your provider know and call our office to update your information.

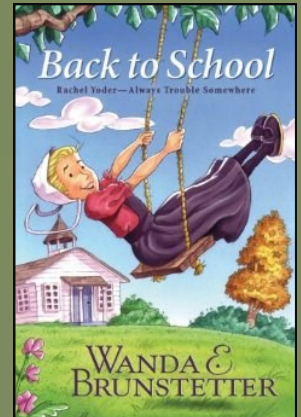
