Cooking Activity

Grilled Tuna Salad Sandwich

- Shredded Carrots
- Canned Tuna
- Chopped Celery
- Chopped Cucumber
- Sliced Tomato
- Sliced Cheese
- Mayonnaise
- Bread
- Butter

Combine carrots, tuna, celery, cucumber and mayo in a bowl, mix well. Butter bread, spread mixture on top and place tomatoes and cheese on top. Place second slice of bread on top. Butter the other sides of each bread and place a cookie rack on top of a cookie sheet and place sandwiches on top of rack. Cook in a 350 degree oven on each side until toasted and cheese is melted. Serve with Tomato soup.


Reminders from the Visitor:

Please check to ensure that your relocation place is still okay, have people moved or are they away for extended periods, if so you will need to change it on your paperwork and with the office.


